



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering this facility, all persons agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

- All persons must conduct themselves in a proper and reasonable manner and in accordance with Basketball SA's Codes of Conduct.
- By entering, all persons agree to be bound by Basketball SA, and where applicable Basketball Australia, rules and by-laws including competition by-laws and the Member Protection Policy. You accept that a breach of rules and by-laws may result in disciplinary procedures.
- Persons entering agree to uphold a child safe environment which is free from harm and where children feel respected, valued and encouraged to reach their full potential. Any person who in the opinion of Basketball SA poses a risk to the safety or wellbeing of a child or young person may be refused entry or evicted from the venue.
- Mobile telephones and cameras are prohibited from use in any change room.
- The act of courtsiding or the transmission of match data in any format, including the services offered by data scouts, data journalists, data commentators, etc. without the express written consent of Basketball Australia is strictly prohibited. Any person suspected of engaging in this conduct will be asked to leave the venue immediately. - Persons entering agree to comply with any reasonable direction of any official connected with basketball.
- The right to remove any person from the facility is reserved if the person's behavior is considered dangerous or unacceptable.
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are prohibited from entering or remaining on the premises.
- Smoking is prohibited in any indoor part of the facility and any outdoor part of the facility so designated.
- Consumption of alcohol is prohibited within the facility except in designated areas (if any).
- The right to refuse entry to the facility is reserved if the person does not agree with any of the conditions of entry.
