- Respect towards the Opponent





This award will inspire all clubs to strive for excellence in their behaviour on and off the






Welcome

Point Scoring System

The 4 finalists from each division play-off for points (listed below). the gold medal winning team receives 5 points, silver receive 3, 3rd receive 2 & 4th receives 1. The points are then added up as follows:

- Male State Champion Club = accumulation of points in the Boys State Divisions
- Female State Champion Club = accumulation of points in the Girls State
 Divisions
- Overall State Champion Club = accumulation of points received in the Boys
 State and Girls State Divisions
- Male Reserve Champion Club = accumulation of points in the Boys Reserve Divisions
- Female Reserve Champion Club = accumulation of points in the Girls Reserve Divisions
- Overall Reserve Champion Club = accumulation of points in the Boys Reserve and Girls Reserve Divisions
